Formal Partnership Agreement between the Community Learning Partnerships in North Yorkshire, York and the East Riding of Yorkshire. July 2017

The Community Learning Partnerships in North Yorkshire, York and the East Riding of Yorkshire have agreed to work closely together to provide vision, direction and challenge of one another on matters that relate to community and adult learning across the YNYER LEP area. They agree:

- To share information about current and planned provision freely and without prejudice so that the totality of provision across YNYER area can be reviewed, developed and improved on a regular basis.
- To share approaches and good practice and support one another.
- To offer, as far as is reasonable and practical, "one voice" about community learning needs and provision to the YNYER LEP.
- To seek additional funding across the area if such an approach is deemed to be the most successful way of proceeding.
- To work together to promote community learning opportunities across the boundaries of the individual local authorities and facilitate the free movement of individuals across those boundaries.

In order to achieve these objectives:

- The chairs of the CLPs will meet on a regular basis (at least three times each year).
- The chairs of the CLPs will each have a right of attendance at each other's meetings.
- The chairs of the CLPs will receive agendas and minutes from each other's meetings.
- Each year the chairs of the CLPs will set a small number of specific tasks that they will seek to achieve collaboratively across the whole LEP area.
