The Access Award, in addition to taught classes, includes access to the Sage Qualifications platform and access to Sage 2021 software for 180 days. After completing the course you will be able to use Sage to set up accounts, produce basic reports showing information entered, keep information safe and store data within Sage.

To complete this recognised AAT qualification, learners must register with AAT in order to sit the assessment and receive access to study support resources via their My AAT account.

Course fees apply, concessions are available depending on your circumstances.

For online delivery via Skype you will need access to a Windows laptop or PC as you will need to download software. A MAC computer is not suitable. You will need access to the internet and an Email account. Your teacher will contact you via Skype/Email, and you will have the opportunity to contribute to group discussions across the County.
