What is MORE for Eastfield?

MORE for Eastfield is a CLLD/Scarborough Borough Council Funded Project running for the next 12-18 months specifically targeted at unemployed or socially inactive residents of Eastfield in Scarborough.

The project is voluntary and is designed to support residents with a range of barriers to education, work and training but also essential life skills.

Overseen by SBC, the project has key staff working on the project from Sparks, Groundwork, Futureworks, WEA and Beyond Housing.

We offer support in the following:

- Training and education
- Health eating and lifestyle
- Confidence, self-esteem
- Self-awareness
- Getting into volunteering
- Mental health and wellness
- Debt and money worries
- Work experience
- CV-writing
- Job Applications

Why are we different from other projects?

- We are delivering in Eastfield, no expectation to travel into Scarborough
- We can offer bespoke (1:1 if necessary) support with a range of key life skills, including all of the above but also basic IT, how to use a smartphone, how to send an email, how to use the internet, in fact pretty much anything that a client sees as a barrier to progressing. We will tailor make our provision to suit our clients and their needs.
- We are delivering face to face in groups and 1:1. We see this as being essential to engage with our clients and create trust (although we can work with clients remotely if they would prefer).
- We can adapt our approach to support existing job search provision that may be being provided by other programmes such as JETS. There is no double funding issue so we are offering additional support to what they are already receiving, which can only be a positive for the client.
- We are not just driven by job outcomes (although they are a key target for us), we want to see our clients progress in so many other ways too, whether it be into education, training or confidence and self esteem.



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- We have a diverse team of specialist staff from across 6 organisations to support individuals in a range of areas.
- We are running craft and cooking classes, menu planning on a budget, family learning sessions, cake decorating and many more. These sessions are all free and delivered locally to Eastfield.
- We are working closely with other approved training and education providers to encourage progression to formalised learning.
- We are running drop-in sessions every day at various community locations across Eastfield.

So who is eligible?

Anyone within the approved postcode area of Eastfield. We can take up to 20% of referrals from outside this area but they must fall within our remit (some areas are exempt). Please see attached postcode checker.

- Clients must be unemployed or economically inactive.
- They must be able to provide evidence to support this.
- They must live in the eligible postcode area.
